# CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION

# A. Background of The Study

Education can be defined as a process where education is conscious effort and full of responsibility from adults in guiding, leading and directing students in various problems and questions that may arise in its implementation. After that, the writing product should fulfill some criteria, such as organization, content, grammar, vocabulary, and mechanics (Brown, 2004). From the ideas above, the researcher deduces that writing is a complex process for conveying or delivering ideas, thoughts, opinions and feelings using combination of letters in written language that other people can understand. Learning writing is one of the competencies that must be taught to students.

Even students often say they cannot though they have not started yet. Students look insecure when given writing assignments. They feel afraid they cannot accomplish the writing assignment since they do not know where to start and end it. From the fact that there are problems faced by students, teachers should look for ways so that students are not discouraged when given the task of writing. So that the researchers look for meansto utilize image media that is attractive to students so that they can motivate them become excited and able to write. In line with the claim that writing is difficult, Pertiwi (2016) states that students have some difficulties in writing. Those difficulties are poor organization, unstructured content, incorrect grammar, word choice, and

mechanics, such as spelling, capitalization, and punctuation. So, teaching writing is not an easy thing, especially when the students' English competence is not well developed. Thus, it demands the care and attention of English teachers. This research chooses one of texts called narrative text. Narrative text is an imaginative story to entertain people. In the narrative text, there is a generic structure (orientation, complication, resolution, and re-orientation).

Instructional media are components of teaching which have great influence in improving students' writing ability. Due to media, the writing teaching-learning process will possess more variation and will be exciting. In the process of learning English, the students must learn four skills, i.e. listening, speaking, reading and writing. In the new modern world, Morse (2016) proposed idea to have additional skills. He stated that people would be required to have six skills to live in a time when the technology is rapidly changing and shape how they communicate and interact each other. The six new skills are listening, speaking, reading, writing, viewing and representing. Viewing and representing are the newest skills that are needed in this era. Many of the comprehension processes involved in reading, such as previewing, predicting, and making inferences, may also be used in viewing. Representing enables students to communicate information and ideas through a variety of media, such as video presentations, posters, diagrams, charts, symbols, visual art, drama, mime, and models. Among all of the language skills, writing is the one skill that realized in written form which is necessary for the academic field (Morse, 2016).

Writing is a highly complex process that requires the ability to create ideas and to display the ideas in a well-structured piece of writing. Before a writer writes something, he or she should check out some aspects. The writer should formulate ideas, organize, and sequence points in logical order, select vocabulary, check for grammatical correctness, spell words correctly, punctuate, and write clearly. As being stated by Fry (2012), before and after writing process, a writer should check their paper. The purpose of checking is to ensure that the writing has good structures to be read and comprehended by the readers. According to

Oshima and Hogue (1998), writing is not easy, it takes to study and practice to develop this skill for both native speakers and new learners.
