# **CHAPTER I**

#### INTRODUCTION

## A. The Background of the Study

Education is very important for human life. The aim of qualifying the human resources is the goal of education itself. The way of qualifying the human resource by having a religious spiritual strength, self-control, personality, intelligence, noble character, and the skills needed by him, society, the nation and the state.
